





The colors of the Italian flag are green, red, and white. To color the flag, color section #1 green and #2 red.




Italy is part of Europe. The capital of Italy is Rome. Famous people from Italy include Leonardo Da Vinci and Christopher Columbus.

The Tower of Pisa is located in Pisa, Italy. It took 199 years to build. The tower leans because the soil under it can't hold it upright.






# THE COLOSSEUM








## MT. VESUVIUS



# PANTHEON
