

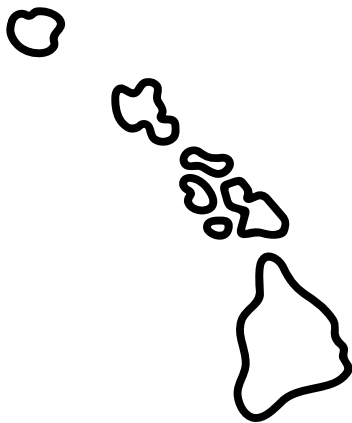
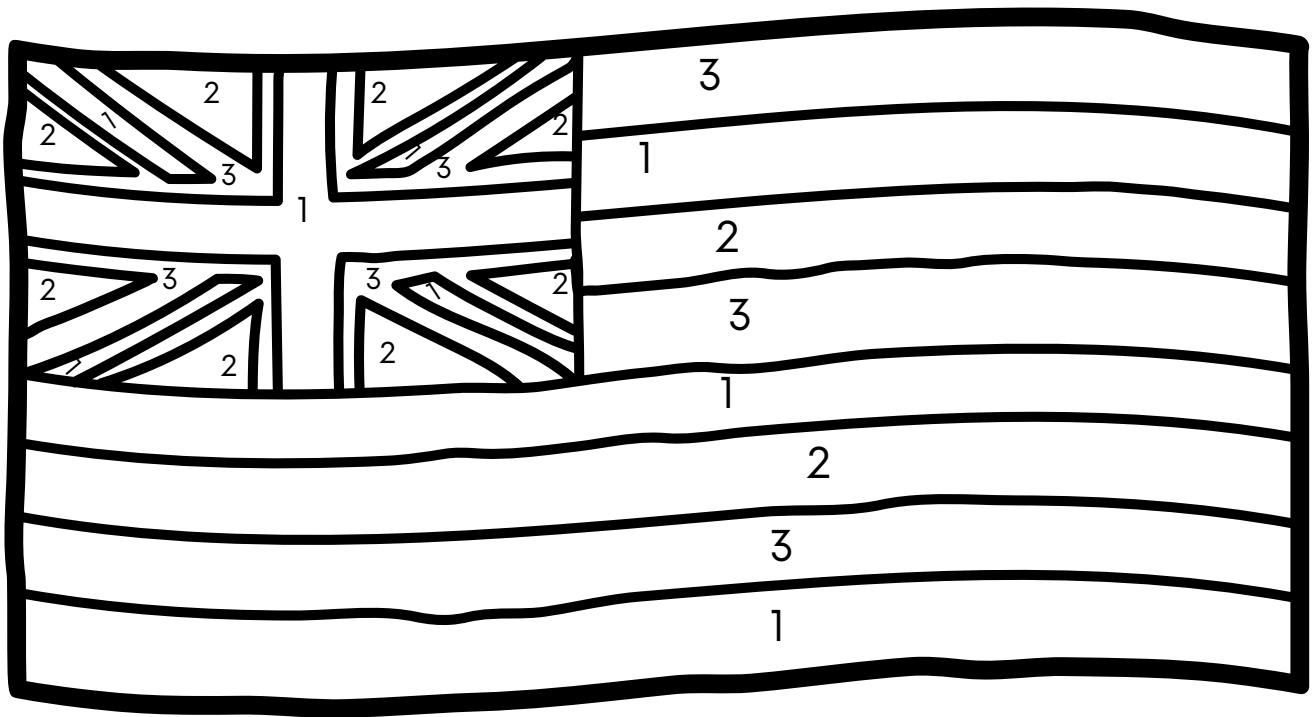

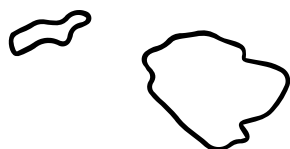
flag



The colors of the Hawaiian flag are red, white, and blue. To color the flag, use the following key:

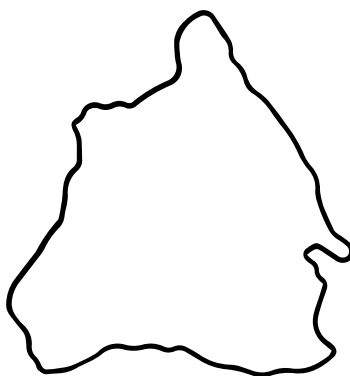
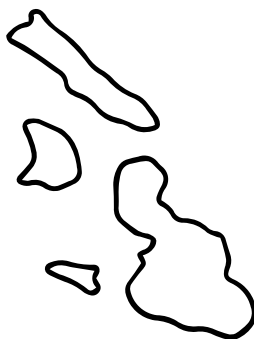
1: RED

Hawaii's nick name is the Aloha State. Aloha is a Hawaiian way to say hello and goodbye!

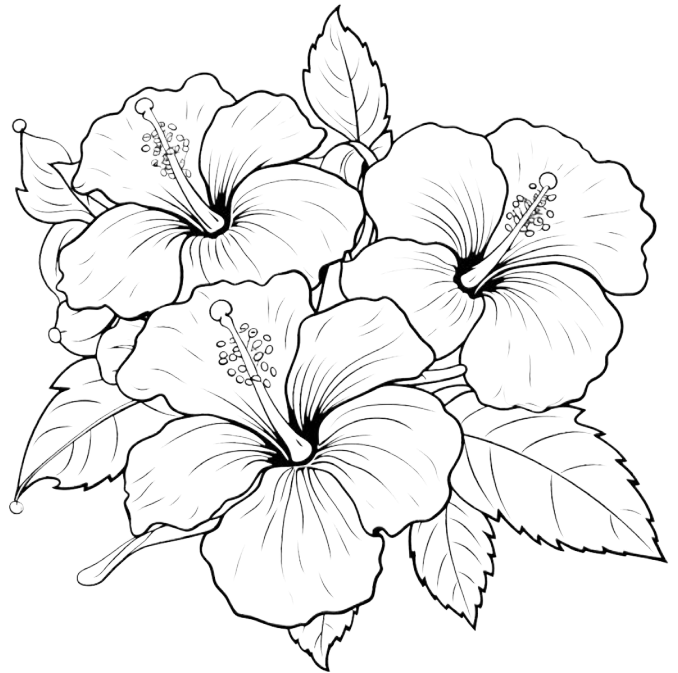

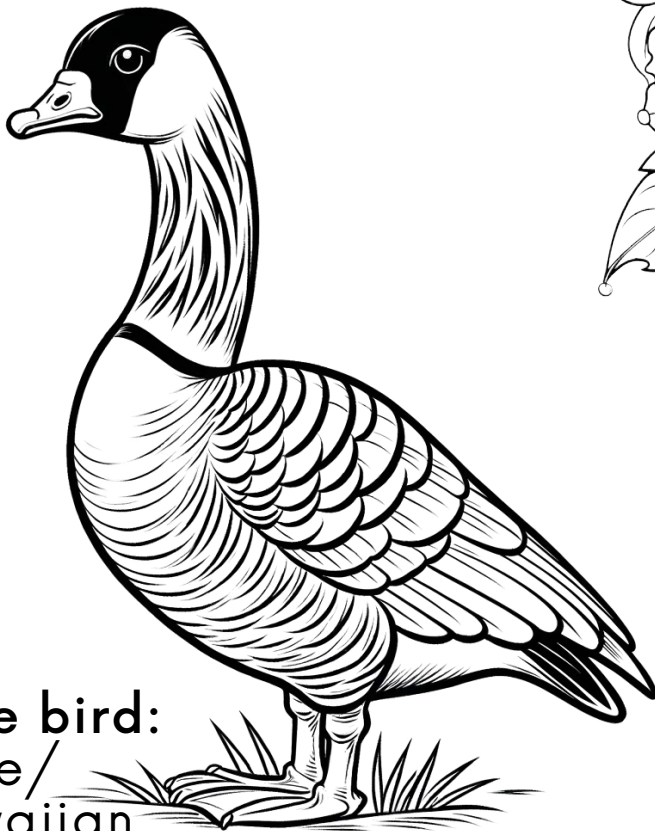

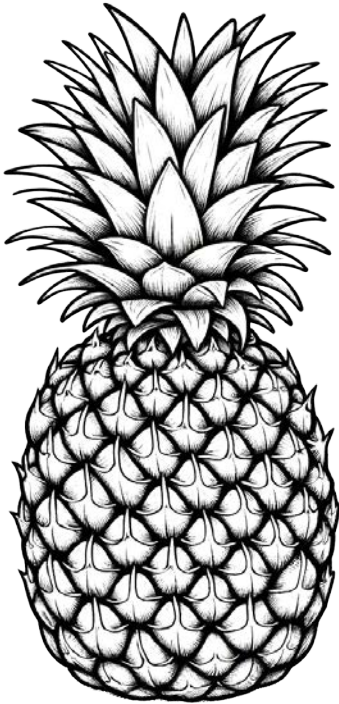

Hawaii's soil is one of its most important natural resource. The rich soil grows things like pineapples, macadamia nuts, sugar cane, and coffee!

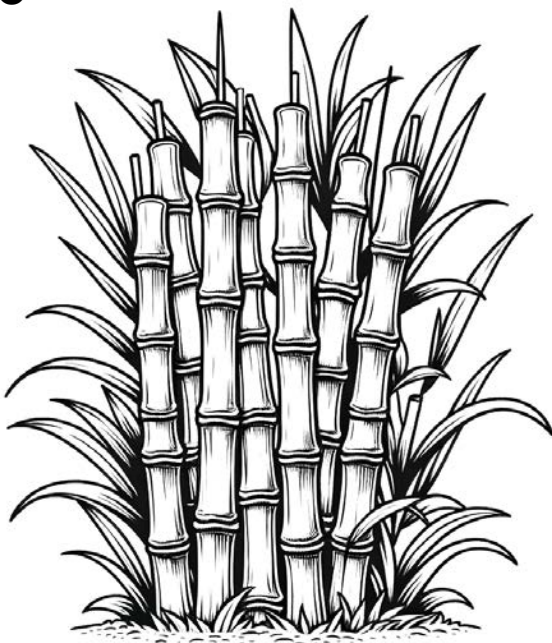

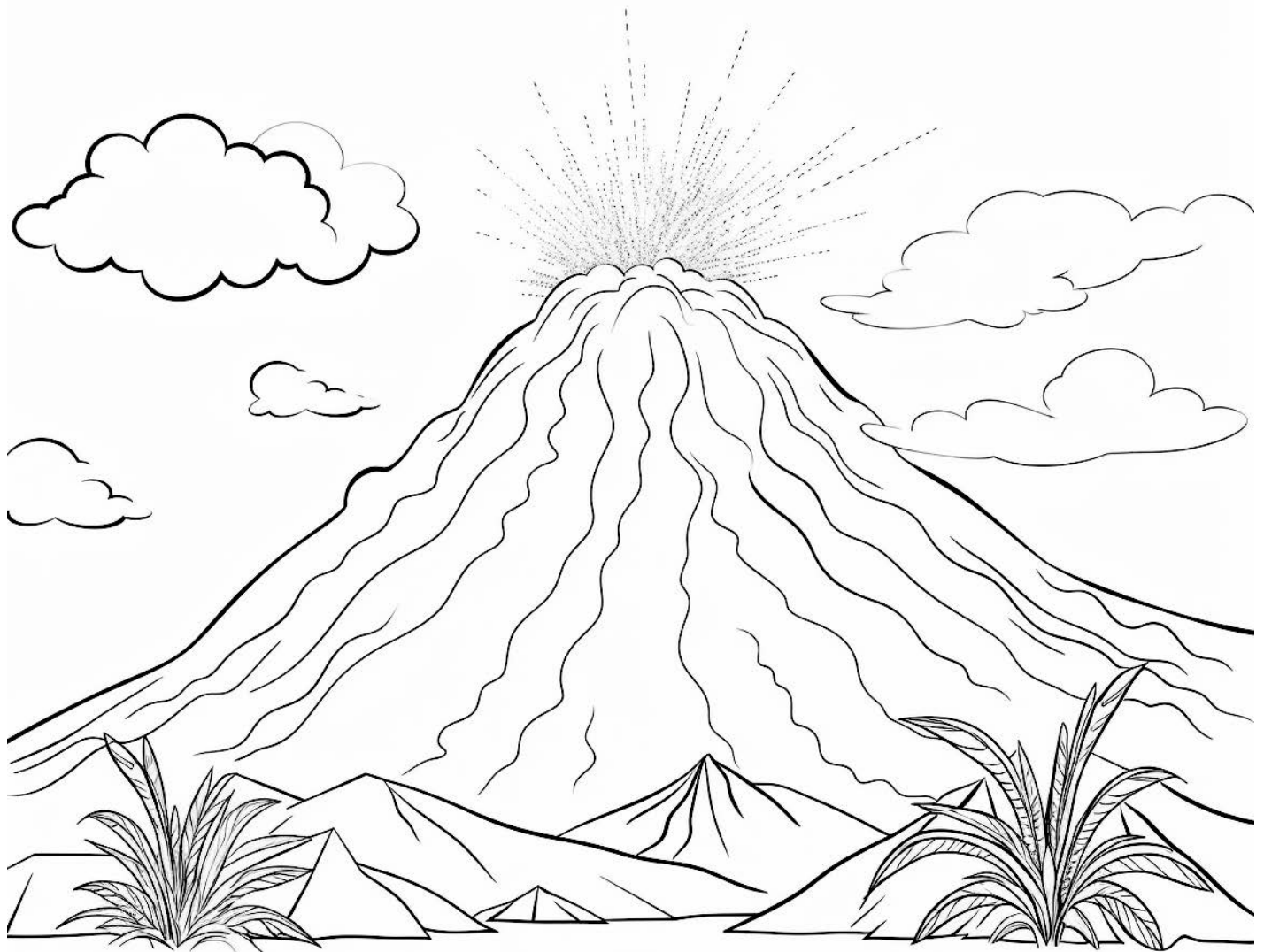
